

<u>Last Week's Collections:</u> Two collections are taken up after the Prayers of the Faithful. The 1^{st} Collection is the Presbytery Collection – this collection is for the support of the local priest, with 13% going towards the support of the retired priests and the Bishop. The 2^{nd} Collection is the Planned Giving (envelopes) for the support of Parish endeavours and structures. 1st Collection (Presbytery – supporting our Priest) \$252.55

2nd Collection (Planned Giving): \$105.00



The results are as follows:

Option 1:

That St Joseph's Blampied finishes as a Sunday Mass centre and remains available for funerals. The number of people who voted for the Church to finish as a mass centre **was total 11. Option 2:**

St Joseph's has Mass on a weekend once a month at 6.00pm Vigil (4^{th} Saturday/Sunday). Total number of people who voted for <u>this option was 5.</u>

Option 4:

A combination of options 2 and 3, that is, one Lay Led Assembly on the weekend of the 2nd Sunday of the month and one Saturday Vigil 6:00pm Mass on the 4th Sunday of the month.

In conducting Lay Led Assembles the following matters need to be considered: The timing of any Lay Led Assembly must not conflict with the timing of any nearby Parish Masses.

St Joseph's community with the Parish Leadership Team will appoint someone to coordinate future Lay Led Assemblies and to be responsible for Mass Set up,

including rosters which are made available to the priest prior to Mass:

Special Ministers/Readers/Offertory/gifts people

Music etc....

Someone from St Joseph's community is to be responsible for oversight of the Church building and grounds.

The roster of available people willing to clean the church needs to be reviewed and a new roster established.

To minimise the Health and Safety issues associated with cleaning of the Church, including the risk to health, the community needs to provide appropriate equipment for people who do cleaning. The total number of people <u>who voted for this option was 39.</u>

As of May 2016 -the new system for the Celebration of Mass and LLA will commence on the second/fourth Sunday of the month. The option that is adopted is option 4.
