

**CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 PRECAUTIONS:** For the health and wellbeing of the people of our diocese, our Vicar General, Fr Kevin Maloney issued a Pastoral Statement on 5<sup>th</sup> March asking us to from now on: Distribute Communion as the Body of Christ only (not via the Chalice) and only on the hand. Those giving Communion are to use hand sanitiser before distributing and are not to physically touch anyone if giving a blessing. Holy water fonts are to be emptied or removed. The Sign of Peace may be given with a smile or a bow instead shaking hands.

**LENT:** Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. Fasting is for those aged 18 to 59. Abstinence from meat on Ash Wednesday, Fridays of Lent and Good Friday for those 14 and over. Lent is a penitential season of prayer, self-denial and helping others as with Christians throughout the world we prepare for Holy Week and Easter. One way we of helping others is through our support for Project Compassion. Please take home envelopes and boxes from each church.
