BISHOPS PASTORAL LETTER ON "ASSISTED DYING" PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Our Victorian bishops are again speaking on behalf of the most vulnerable in our society in releasing another Pastoral Letter on 9th October (on 9/10/2017) about proposed legislation euphemistically named "Voluntary Assisted Dying Bill 2017." This endorses suicide rather than committing greater funding for better aged care facilities and end of life care. Copies of this letter are at the back of the church with an attached list of six major failures or limitations in this proposed new law.
