After a week of peace and tranquillity on the Aragonese Camino, today I reached Obanos where this joins the Camino Frances made famous in the film "The Way " and numerous documentaries. This is like enjoying the solitariness of walking Scent Farm road to Bealiba then suddenly meeting the Calder Highway. No maps or directions are needed as waves of pilgrims are surging along this to Santiago de Compostela and one merely needs to "go with the flow." I'm staying at the same de los Padres Reparados albergue we found very comfortable in 2013. Even though its tarrif has increased from 5e back then to now 7e = \$10, its still superb value. In some parts of the northern hemisphere in July it's the land of the midnight sun. Here in central Spain its now the land of the midday sun! 38-40 degrees is necessitating being on the road by 6.00am and the umbrella that protected me from showers in the cooler, wetter Pyrenees is now shielding me from the burning Sun. So much for the rain in Spain staying mainly on The plain. I think this is a furphy and the opposite is far more the case. While the Spanish do most things very cheaply and very well, they're not good at contouring. Every big and small hill has a track going up and over rather than around. As always, those one meets along The Way are highlights of every camino. This is proving to be no exception and the way peregrinos care for one another is outstanding. Not to overlook the ever-consistent superb quality of Spanish food and wine that make this a great place to be even if one isn't walking the Camino!
