FR PAUL MERCOVICH – **FUNERAL DETAILS:** Following Fr Paul's death while holidaying at Alice Springs on 22nd September, his Funeral Mass will be at Immaculate Conception church, St Arnaud 10.30am Friday 13th October then 3.00pm burial at Ararat cemetery. A Vigil Mass will be celebrated at St Joseph's, Charlton 7.00pm Thursday 12th October. Paul was ordained in Ararat on 31st May 1969, served as assistant priest in Koroit, Camperdown, Colac and Cathedral parishes, administrator of Birregurra parish and parish priest of Inglewood, Ouyen, Charlton (twice), Ballarat East and St Arnaud. A teacher before he trained as a priest, Fr Paul chaired our Diocesan Education Board in the 1980's and 1990's and was also a police chaplain. He was parish priest of Inglewood (Jan. 1977–Feb. 1978) when this was part of the Ballarat diocese and included Bealiba, Dunolly and Tarnagulla till in February 1978 these became part of Maryborough parish and the rest of Inglewood parish was transferred to Sandhurst diocese.
