LENT: is a special time of fasting and almsgiving within Christian Communities. Our usual form of "Giving" during Lent is through Project Compassion.

PROJECT COMPASSION: this year marks 50 years of Project Compassion and the Theme chosen for the year is, "*Learning More, Creating Change.*" So this year our donations will go towards working with local partners around the world to provide vital learning and renewed hope to children, women and men most vulnerable to extreme poverty and injustice.

There are two main ways of making your donation:

- 1. Through the weekly envelopes. (These can be placed on the collection plate each Sunday)
- 2. Through taking home a Project Compassion Box and encouraging all the family members to make regular contributions.

 The boxes are then returned to the Church on Easter Sunday.
