Its ironic this Bill is put forward at a time we are most concerned about younger people taking their lives and trying to do all we can to support them with alternatives while signalling to vulnerable older people its ok to take your life. Some copies of "When Life is Ending" and "Real Care, Love and Compassion" leaflets are also at the back of St Augustine's church.
