CLEMENTE PROGRAM BALLARAT. The Clemente Program is a national educational program taught in Ballarat by Australian Catholic University and Federation University, in partnership with Centacare, The Smith Family, The Ballarat Foundation and The City of Ballarat. This program aims to transform the lives of people facing one or more forms of disadvantage such as unemployment, mental illness, homelessness and substance abuse. Students take one university-level course in the Humanities each semester, and after completing four are awarded with a Certificate of Liberal Arts from ACU. No fees – all costs covered by the organisations involved. Clemente is open to anyone, eighteen years old to retired. The next semester begins at the start of August, "Introduction to International Relations" taught by Dr Carolyn Johnstone of Federation University. Classes are at Ballarat Library twice a week - one a lecture and the other a Learning Support session. Free lunch provided on both days and the atmosphere is relaxed and friendly.
