ST. VINCENT de PAUL, September 27th. St. Vincent de Paul was born about 1581. He was ordained in 1600. He resolved to devote his life to works of charity. He did much to relieve the sufferings of prisoners held on the galleys. He founded confraternities of charity for men and women, working with Pierre de Berulle and Louise de Marillac. The Sisters of Charity, whose work was with the sick and poor, was the first congregation of women without enclosure. He died in 1660.

ST. JEROME, September 30th. St. Jerome was born about 342. He lived for some years as a hermit in the Syrian desert, then returned to Antioch and was ordained priest by Paulinus. He translated the Bible from its original language into Latin, wrote biblical commentaries and other works. He fought against the heresies of Arianism, Pelagianism and Origenism. He died in 420.
