


2020 PLENARY COUNCIL: Pentecost Sunday, was the official beginning of our Parish, Diocese and Australia-wide preparation for a Plenary Council in October 2020 when people will gather in Adealide to discern where the Holy Spirit is leading us into the future and follow this up with a further gathering in 2021. A time of listening to each other encouraging us to share our stories of faith and ideas and questions. We're invited to prepare for this by reflecting on the question: "What do we think God is asking of us in Australia at this time?"
