There have been times confronted by fierce dogs protecting livestock, long horned cattle coming towards me along narrow lanes (running with the bulls would be easier as you're going in the same direction), spectacular views obscured by fog till late morning and most of all sharing the way with thousands of fellow pilgrims from across the world converging on Santiago for the feast of St James, 25th July. The final few days have been a nice "warm down" along undulating forest paths through the beautiful Galicia region after the rigors of the mountains. While the San Salvador and Primitivo are among the lesser walked Caminos and good for solitude and peace, once one connects with the Camino Frances at Melide 53 km from Santiago, this becomes a "pilgrim highway" ant trail including a number of family groups with young children and lots of secondary/tertiary students taking advantage of their July-August mid year break. I hope to fill in the next few days with a couple of shorter, flatter walks before flying to Dublin on Sunday 29th then onto Killarney to spend a few days with our ordination Golden Jubilarian and former Maryborough parish assistant priest, Fr Denis Dennehy, and his family before beginning the homeward trek and arriving back on 4th August. **Fr John.**
