On the **Feast of the Transfiguration**, we are called to fill our hearts with the love of Jesus through prayer, so that as we 'descend' we 'transfigure' this prayer into action. 8th August is Saint Mary's Feast Day—a day we celebrate the life and legacy of Australia's first Saint. At the age of 24, Mary dedicated her life to God taking on the name "Mary of the Cross". Along with Fr Julian Tenison-Woods, a young Mary opened a school in a disused stable in Penola, South Australia. Her unwavering vision was to educate the poor, underprivileged children, of which there were many. Many other women came to join her there, and Mary and Julian founded the Sisters of St Joseph. The deep faith of the Sisters provided them the inspiration to serve the poorest, seeing the face of Jesus in each and every person. They were drawn to the remotest corners of Australia, living in tents in the harshest conditions, working alongside the local people.

This strong leadership **Mary** espoused created the foundations of the Catholic schooling system in Australia. Now, over 150 years later, we invite parishioners to spread **Mary's** vision throughout the world, to Papua New Guinea and many other countries, leading others to a full and dignified life, through prayer and action.
