FR BOB MAGUIRE AND ST AUGUSTINE'S PARISH:

Fr Bob Maguire had an association with our parish for several years, beginning in the mid 1970's. Back then, the Maryborough branch of the KSC (Knights of the Southern Cross) organised a Men's Communion Dinner each year. Mass would be in the church, followed by Dinner in the Parish Hall. At the Dinner there would be a guest speaker. In 1975, Fr Bob was to celebrate the Mass and be guest speaker at the Dinner. However, that year there was no Parish Hall. I had become parish priest here in 1974, after being assistant here to Fr Tom Scanlan who retired home to Ireland in May of that year. Our primary school lacked a playground back then. We acquired some houses along Burke St & one in Burns St, selling them for removal to create a playing field. We also demolished the Parish Hall, replacing it with the Parish Centre which fitted easily between the back of the presbytery and Burns St. Where the Hall had been we constructed the Netball / Basketball / Tennis Courts, which have now become a car park. Having no Hall, we decided to have the Mass and the Dinner at Lou Maffescioni's Flagstaff Hotel, with Fr Bob doing the honours. He arrived about an hour late, by which time many of the men were drinking beer. Fr Bob apologised for arriving late and dispensed them from the Hour's fast before receiving Holy Communion (which caused ructions among a couple of Law & Order parishioners.) Regardless, it was a great evening. Thereafter, for the rest of my time here as pastor, Fr Bob would celebrate and preach at the Men's Communion Mass but we'd have another guest speaker at the Dinner. Fr Pat Flanagan
