Confirmation is the second sacrament of initiation. The Bishop (or his deputy) confirms a person's Baptism through anointing with oil of Chrism. Through the laying on of hands over the head of the confirmee, the Bishop (or his deputy) invokes a further outpouring of the Holy Spirit that enhances a candidate's **giftedness** and encourages them to put their **gifts** at the service of the Community.

Session 2—God Speaks, We Listen

God speaks to us in many different ways in our everyday lives. When we gather together as God's family and listen to the Scriptures, God speaks to us. The Gospels, which tell us about Jesus, are especially important because it is through Jesus that God speaks most directly to us.

AIMS:

- To reflect on the many ways in which God speaks to us.
- To understand that the story of God speaking comes to us through Scripture.
- To know that God is most fully revealed in the person of Jesus.
