The Synod of Bishops will include female voting members for the first time.

Pope Francis has approved changes to allow lay women, including religious sisters, and lay men, to take part as full members of the Synod summit in October, emphasising that it restores a model of the Church as the "People of God" and where the hierarchy is in close relationship with the laity. Women have only ever taken part as "auditors" or observers without the right to vote on its outcomes. The changes, which mean that 75 per cent of the Synod assembly this October will be bishops and 25 per cent non-bishops, are seen as a move by the Synod away from a gathering of the hierarchy towards a Synod of the people. The Holy Father explored how Jesus himself chose to present His message. In the synagogue of Nazareth, at the very beginning of his public ministry, the Pope recalled, the Lord revealed that fulfilling Isaiah's prophecy, He came to proclaim Good News to the poor and a year of favour from the Lord. The Pope said Jesus communicated with certain essential elements, especially joy, freedom, light, healing & awe. "One cannot speak of Jesus without joy, because faith is a wonderful love story to be shared..." To witness to Jesus to something for others in His name, the Pope recalled, witnesses such a beautiful gift "that no words are sufficient to express it." Instead, when joy is lacking, the Pope warned, the Gospel is not transmitted to others, the Good News, by its very nature, is "a proclamation of joy." "A sad Christian can speak of beautiful things, but it is all in vain if the proclamation conveyed is not joyful," he said.

The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfil the Lord's instruction to, "Pray the Lord of the harvest to send labourers into his harvest" (Mt 9:38; Lk 10:2).
