OUR DIOCESE TURNS 150

In March next year, our Diocese of Ballarat will turn 150.

It was on March 30, 1874, that Pope Pius the Ninth issued a decree that marked the beginning of the Ballarat Diocese. So, on March 30, 2024, we will be able to celebrate our 150th birthday!

The 150th anniversary will occur on March 30, which in 2024 happens to be Holy Saturday. This means that we will be able to mark the anniversary as we celebrate the Easter Vigil.

While we will be able to mark the 150th anniversary at Easter, we could celebrate the whole of 2024 as an anniversary year. I invite parishes to mark the 150th anniversary at Masses on the weekend of April 27-28, I invite schools to mark the anniversary during the week of April 29 to May 3. I hope to mark the anniversary year with a personal visit to each parish. I would love to celebrate the 150th anniversary year as bishop by visiting people throughout the diocese in the course of 2024.
