COMMEMORATING THE 30TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE VISIT OF SAINT JOHN PAUL 11 TO

AUSTRALIA. On Sunday, November 27, 2016, the Catholic Church in Australia will commemorate the 30th Anniversary of the visit of Saint John Paul II to Australia in 1986. The Bishops Commission for Relations with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Peoples (BCRATSIP) is calling on parishes, schools and communities to mark the anniversary of Saint John Paul's address to the Aboriginal community in Blatherskite Park, Alice Springs on November 29, 1986.

THE DIOCESAN ECOLOGICAL SUSTAINABILITY GROUP (ECOS) are encouraging parishes to spread the word of *Laudato Si*. There will be information sent regularly to parishes to include on parish bulletins and other information is available from the diocesan website www.ballarat.catholic.org.au A challenge from Laudato Si: On care for our common home. (Pope Francis, 2015): Laudato Si reminds us that each one of us has a distinctive gift to offer our world and we each have a part to play. "All of us can co-operate as instruments of God for the care of creation, each according to his or her own culture, experience, involvements and talents" (LS 14). To achieve this belief, we must first recognize that there is a deep interconnection between all created things. ACTION: Use fewer paper and plastic products – use a re-usable water bottle, use cloth bags for shopping.
