MASS RESTRICTIONS: Thanks to Premier Daniel Andrews revised rural restrictions. we can now have Mass for up to 20 people inside rather than outside at Avoca and Dunolly. From today, Sunday 1st November, our St Kevin's, Avoca 8.30am Mass on 1st and 3rd Sundays will recommence. From Sunday 8th November, our St Mary's, Dunolly 8.30am Mass on 2nd and 4th Sundays will recommence. As previously advised, these Masses are ONLY for those who regularly attend these respective Mass centres so we do not have to turn anyone away. Lists of those attending and the usual COVID-19 sanitary requirements will apply.
