With sadness I share the news that Fr Frank Smith died last night (2 August 2023).

Fr Frank had strong links with Ballarat. In the 1960s he did his studies for the priesthood at the Redemptorist Seminary in Wendouree. Then in recent years, he lived in Wendouree West, serving the local people as a member of the Exodus community. When his health declined, he moved to Melbourne for medical care. He died at the Berengarra Aged Care Facility in Kew.

This year Fr Frank celebrated 60 years of religious profession as a Redemptorist. We will let you know details of the funeral once arrangements have been made.

May Christ the Redeemer welcome Fr Frank into eternal life.
