Last week we mentioned the six themes for discernment taken from the responses to the question "What do you think God is asking us in Australia at this time?" The first theme calls on the Church to be *Missionary and Evangelising*. A comprehensive report on what people said will be released on 28 July. Meanwhile, we know that the first theme sought new ways of living and proclaiming the Gospel, stronger leadership in parishes and schools and effective leadership training. Some people called for a married priesthood, a greater focus on Jesus Christ, a greater role for women and more effective listening to the Holy Spirit and to one another.
