
Divine Renovation: from a maintenance to a missional parish. Some parishioners have already volunteered

DURING THE FLU SEASON

As we've entered the cold and flu season, a number of precautions have been adopted:

- **Hand sanitiser** is available at the church entrance.
- During the sign of peace, parishioners are asked to **refrain from shaking hands**, and instead express the Lord's peace with a simple bow.
- **Communion under both kinds** will continue, in accord with our Lord's instructions to eat his Body and drink his Blood. However, drinking from the chalice is always an option — not an obligation — and those who abstain from the chalice still receive the fullness of the Lord's Body and Blood in the Sacred Host.

(NB: Church law prohibits communicants from dipping the host in the chalice. Self-intinction risks accidental desecration, as a drop of the Precious Blood might be spilled on the floor.)

SCRIPTURE REFLECTION by Sr Dianne Bergant csa

The multiplication of the loaves and fishes prefigures the eschatological banquet of fulfilment. It also prefigures the miracles of Jesus as he changed the bread and wine into his own Body and Blood. Jesus handed himself over as food and drink on the very night that he was handed over by others.

The banquet Jesus prepared for us is the interim meal for the Christian community. We are to feed on it until the Lord returns. The Eucharistic meal is a re-enactment of Christ's death, an anticipatory celebration of his coming, and a thanksgiving banquet with him present.
