Bishop Paul 's Easter Message

In his 2023 Easter message to the people of the Diocese of Ballarat, Bishop Paul outlines the plans for the 150th anniversary of the Diocese of Ballarat in April 2024.

The 150th anniversary will be an opportunity for us to discern how we as the People of God in the communities of faith throughout the Diocese that stretches 'from the Murray to the Sea'can develop the synodal way of walking together in faith, listening to each other through genuine dialogue in order to discern what the Holy Spirit is asking of us in response to the many challeng es of our time.

The 150th anniversary will provide us to acknowledge our heritage and those who have laid the foundations of our parishes, schools, health care facilities and social services. It will also be an opportunity to acknowledge our strengths and weakness, our achievements and failures to live our Christian life to the full.

In preparation for the 150th anniversary of the Diocese, Bishop Paul asks each parish to focus in 2023 on Leadership, in parish councils and leadership teams. In 2024 A Diocesan Assembly will be held with representatives of local leadership teams, from which a Diocesan Mission and Pastoral Council will be formed ...

In 2025 the Diocesan Mission and Pastoral Council will lead the preparations for a Diocesan Synod that will be held in 2026 - 2027. The Synod will consider how we in the Diocese of Ballarat will implement the various decrees of the 2022 Plenary Council of the Australian Catholic Church.

Bishop Paul offers us the peace of Christ as we celebrate with joy the resurrection of Christ!
