

RCIA Rite of Election at St Patrick's Cathedral Ballarat Both Creswick and Daylesford Parishes were amongst those in the Diocese that presented to Bishop Paul adults who have commenced the process of Christian initiation with catechumens and baptised candidates for reception into full communion with the Catholic Church. Many thanks to those parishioners who also joined in this celebration following the Rite of enrolment of Names that had been celebrated at both churches in the preceding weeks.

Diocese of Ballarat 150th anniversary (1874 - 2024) As we came to Ash Wednesday, when we gathered with Christians across the world to mark the beginning of the season of Lent, we acknowledged the God who calls us to repentance, to be conscious of our sinfulness and to ask for healing and forgiveness. This year, acknowledging 150 years of history of the Diocese of Ballarat, we reflect on those years in particular, recognising our failures over that time to be the people God called us to be. Individually and collectively we ask God's mercy and forgiveness. We ask forgiveness for our failings over the 150 years since the foundation of the Diocese. In this anniversary year we ask for pardon.

At the 150th anniversary Mass of the Oils (11.30am Monday March 25th), each parish is invited to bring in the entrance procession a symbol or photo representing them. The Daylesford Parish will develop a photo collage including St Peter's, the former Holy Cross Convent, St Francis Xavier Chapel and Cemetery Eganstown (the only Catholic Cemetery in the Ballarat Diocese) as well as photos of former Churches in the parish: St Joseph's Blampied, St Bernard's Hepburn, St Paul's Glenlyon, St John's Yandoit, St Patrick's Korweinguboora. Photos of these former churches or of celebrations such as first communion or weddings celebrated there are being sought from parishioners to that we might develop the photo collage.
