2021 Census- The changing face of Australia's religious community

The 2021 Census revealed that the Australian community shows much diversity in its religious make up. Christianity continued to be the most common of the religious groups, by far, comprising 43.9 per cent of the population, a decrease from 52.1 per cent in the 2016 Census.

Australians identifying with non-Christian religions grew from 8.2 per cent of the population in 2016 to ten per cent in 2021. The percentage of Australians not identifying with any religious group continued to grow, and in 2021 made up 38.9 per cent of the population, up from 30.1 per cent in 2016. Although the religion question is the only optional question in the Census, it was completed by 93 per cent of all Australians.

One in five Australians identify as Catholic According to the 2021 Census, Catholics comprised around twenty per cent of the Australian population, a slight decrease from the previous Census in 2016, when Catholics made up 22.6 per cent of all Australians. The decline continued in 2021, when there were around 215,000 fewer people identifying as Catholic than five years prior in 2016.
