### Safeguarding Information:

With the introduction of the new Child Safe standards from July 1<sup>st</sup> Standard One requires both parishes to establish a culturally safe environment in which the diverse and unique identities & experience of Aboriginal children & young people are respected. Members of both parishes Leadership team and Council are applying for Police Checks.

#### Stewardship:

Both meetings received the annual statement of parish income and expenditure for the 2021-22 financial year. Parishioners will receive a copy in the coming weeks.

The Daylesford parish has entered into an agreement with Hygge, the developers of Middleton Field, so that the Parish land at the back of St Michael's school (East side) can be accessed and subdivided and sold as part of the staged development of the site. The Daylesford team approved the purchase of a new data projector screen (and remotes!).

Creswick parishioners will resume counting the collections at Creswick with the formation of several counting teams whose members are applying for Police Checks.
