

## Migrant and Refugee Sunday



This year's Migrant and Refugee Sunday, 25 Sept 2022, marks the 108<sup>th</sup> World Day of Migrants and Refugees. In his Message for this year's World Day of Migrants and Refugees (see below), Pope Francis speaks to the theme of his Message: 'Building the future with migrants and refugees'.

"In the light of what we have learned in the tribulations of recent times", says Pope Francis, "we are called to renew our commitment to building a future that conforms ever more fully to God's plan of a world in which everyone can live in peace and dignity".

In his Message Pope Francis speaks of God's all-embracing inclusiveness: "No one must be excluded. God's plan is essentially inclusive and gives priority to those living on the existential peripheries. Among them are many migrants and refugees, displaced persons, and victims of trafficking." "Building the future with migrants and refugees," says Pope Francis, "also means recognizing and valuing how much each of them can contribute to the process of construction."
