EPIPHANY WATER: A special blessing of holy water can be made on the Vigil of Epiphany. Fr Bill will minister this blessing on Saturday and you are welcome to bring your own container to fill with Epiphany water. The blessed water will be available in all churches over the next week (Epiphanytide).

EPIPHANY CHALK: Chalk will be blessed at each Mass this weekend. Those who wish can take a piece of chalk home and minister a home blessing for the new year. Instructions are available with the chalk. To dispose of blessed chalk, simply dissolve it in water and pour the water in the garden, or bury the chalk directly in your garden.
