Epiphany Blessings

This weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. Blessings, otherwise known as Chalking the Door, have been around since Medieval times, where Christians following the Biblical precedent of the ancient Israelites chalked their doors with the initials of the three wise men. Parishioners are invited to take home blessed chalk and Epiphany water from the churches (this weekend and next) and bless their homes. Alternatively, Fr Bill will be available for Epiphany blessings through the month of January by appointment through the Parish Office.
