St Pius XI instituted this **Feast of Christ the King** in 1925.

It celebrates God's reign over all the earth.

When Pope Pius XI was elected pope (1922), much of the world was in shambles. While the bloodletting of World War 1 (1914-1918) had ended, widespread peace and tranquillity were not evident.

The Pope aimed to remind Catholics that true peace and justice could only be achieved by acknowledging Christ's rule.
