

'Listening and journeying together' during Laudato Si' Week

On 24 May, we mark the seventh anniversary of Pope Francis' encyclical letter Laudato Si': On Care for Our Common Home. Pope Francis has helped Catholics to understand the connection people have to the whole of creation and that caring for the entire community of people and Earth is central to mission. The Australian Catholic Bishops Conference (ACBC) invites Catholic parishes and communities to celebrate Laudato Si' Week from 16 to 24 May in acknowledgement and appreciation of the holistic approach to care for God's creation in the Pope's message. The ACBC's Office for Justice, Ecology and Peace says that while global social and ecological crises, including the COVID-19 pandemic, illustrate what communities can achieve together, they also reveal the need for coordination and support.
