Catholics around Australia have met and listened to Sr Nathalie Becquart ZMCJ, the most senior woman I the Vatican who will become the first woman to vate in the upcoming Synod of Bishops.

We are living in a time that requires a radical shift from the 'business as usual' approach'," he said. "It is time to embrace a new paradigm of equitable, sustainable, harmonious, shared life with and for all."

"We don't just need to do old things better," he said. "What we need is to be a truly humble, listening, inclusive and synodal church." Bishop Vincent explained what this looks like in his own diocese, where he has been working to transform the Diocese of Parramatta to practise synodality.

"We are structuring our diocese so there is active collaboration between clergy and laity, a diverse membership in governance structures, and we emphasise accountability. "This is a very special time for the Church, and, as you know, we are altogether, everywhere in the world, living this synod now," she said. She explained the synod is "at the service of an ongoing call to deepen the reception of the Second Vatican Council", that "we are called to live synodality dimensions. So, what lies ahead is that each of us must become a synod—we must become a synodal sister, a synodal teacher, a synodal priest, a synodal bishop."More Link: https://catholicoutlook.org/sr-nathalie-becquart-xmcj-in-
