Pope Francis's recovery from surgery

is going well but doctors have advised him not to deliver his Sunday blessing from a hospital balcony The Vatican spokesperson, Matteo Bruni, said the pope noon Angelus prayer in his hospital suite. Alfieri said the pope was taken off intravenous tubes on Friday and

had started a semi-liquid diet. All medical parameters were within the norm, there were no cardiac problems and complete healing of the abdominal scars would take about three months. Doctors had said after the operation that the pope should have no limitations on travels and other activities after recovery. He has trips to Portugal on 2-6 August for World Youth Day and a visit to the Shrine of Fatima, and to Mongolia from 31 August to 4 September, one of the remotest places he will have visited. One of the last people to see Francis on Wednesday before he left the Vatican for the hospital was the Rev. Enzo Fortunato, spokesman of the Basilica of St Francis of Assisi.

He was very serene, very tranquil, and he encouraged us to go on," Fortunato recalled. "This really hit me because it means he is not a man who is self-centred but focused on others. We said to him "Courage, and we will support you with our prayers."
