Faithful invited to pray for Synod of Bishops: The Vatican is asking all baptised people, regardless of whether they will be in Rome, to participate in October's assembly of the Synod of Bishops with their prayers. "The Synod is first and foremost an event of prayer and listening does not solely involve the members of the synodal assembly, but every baptised person, every particular Church," the letter read. "Indeed, all are called in this moment to join ourselves to the communion of prayer and in the insistent invocation of the Holy Spirit so it may guide us in the discernment of what the Lord asks today of his Church."
