Thank you for your continued support and partnership with **Catholic Development Fund** (CDF) following the recent announcement of the CDF merger. (Ballarat, Sale & Bunbury Diocese to merge with Melbourne.

As part of our ongoing commitment to provide you with the best possible experience, we want to inform you of upcoming changes to interest rates that may impact your CDF accounts. From I January 2024, there will be an increase in CDF interest rates. This adjustment will see a net-benefit for all Ballarat customers, while aligning rates currently offered to CDF customers in other Dioceses. All current CDF Term Investment and Savings accounts will see an increase across current rates, with the new interest rates effective from I January 2024. The increase will be applied to every Term Investment account from this date, including those yet to reach maturity, for the remaining term. Please note that interest on Term Investments will be paid upon maturity and Savings accounts will be credited with interest annually on 31 December 2023.

Term Investments: Cheque/Premium Savings:

CDF has also reviewed the Standard Variable Loan and Overdraft rate, and will be increasing both to 6.20% p.a. These new rates are also effective from 1 January 2024.
