TRIBUTE TO FRANK COSTA

Former Geelong captain <u>Tom Harley</u> caught up with Mr Costa for a coffee in recent weeks to say thank you. "He was obviously very driven and self-motivated and his life centred around his family, his footy and *his Faith*, Harley said. He was a great man who transcended the footy club and one of the things I feel most fortunate about in my life is spending over a decade under the leadership of Frank and I was fortunate to be very close to him as a player. "He was very much a values-based person in the way he led his

family, the way he led his business and the way he led the footy club.

Des Tobin wrote Frank Costa's biography "Family, Faith & Footy. "He understood in business you have to understand your business, you have to understand your product, you have to understand your customer, and you have to provide the customers what they need, and you need to pay your bills and you need to be fair, don't rip anyone off", Mr Tobin said. "He was just a good and decent, generous man and that's reflected in everything – the way he lived his life, the way he raised his family, the way he changed the course of the Geelong Football Club."

Father Kevin Dillon a long-time parish priest at Frank's beloved St Mary's often described his friend as the "King of Geelong." He said the Costa Legacy stretched to countless charities, causes and organisations, all of whom would grieve the news of Franks' death. "Frank was just the humblest of people. He never had any tickets on himself. He was successful, he was influential, but he didn't put himself above anybody else." Fr Dillon said. "There are lots of phrases that will be used about Frank and there won't be any negative ones, but none of them will be exaggerated. "The esteem in which Frank has been held has never dimmed, not because Frank was seeking the limelight but because he was the natural 'go to person', within the footy club and within the community, where his voice and wisdom to be just an ordinary bloke who spoke common sense and set good standards was always taken on board."
