Walk with those experiencing

depression: Pope

People experiencing depression often need someone to talk to, and they can benefit from psychological counselling and reading what Jesus has to say, Pope Francis says.


"Let us pray that people who suffer from depression or burnout will find support and a light that opens them up to life," the Pope said. In a video message released by the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network yesterday, Francis offered his prayer intention for the month of November, which he dedicated to people experiencing depression. In his video message, the Pope said, "Overwork and work-related stress cause many people to experience extreme exhaustion – mental, emotional, affective and physical exhaustion." "Sadness, apathy and spiritual tiredness end up dominating the lives of people, who are overloaded due to the rhythm of life today," he added.

"Let us try to be close to those who are exhausted, to those who are desperate, without hope. "Often, we should just simply listen in silence because we cannot go and tell someone, 'No, life's not like that. Listen to me, I'll give you the solution.' There's no solution," he said.

"And besides, let us not forget that, along with the indispensable psychological counselling, which is useful and effective, Jesus' words also help," he said, words such as, "Come to me, all you who labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest".

XVI Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops



The journey towards the celebration of the Synod in October 2023 solemnly opened on October 9-10, 2021 in Rome, and on October 17 in each particular Church.

On September 7, 2021, the preparatory document and the vademecum (handbook) for the synodal journey were released. With the convocation of the Synod of Bishops on the themes of communion, participation and mission, Pope Francis invites the entire Church to reflect on a theme that is decisive for its life and mission: "It is precisely this path of synodality which God expects of the Church of the third millennium. This journey, which follows in the wake of the Church's 'renewal' proposed by the Second Vatican Council, is both a gift and a task."
