Redan: Wed. 9.30am, Sat 6.00pm, Sun 9.00am - 30 people - vaccination status not required Thurs. 9.30am Mass - 35 People 16 years and over, double vaccination certificate upon entry
Linton: Sun 9.00am - 24 people - vaccination status not required
Skipton: Sun 10.30am - 24 people - vaccination status not required
Snake Valley: Sat 6.30pm - 24 people - vaccination status not required
Sebastopol: Fri 9.30am, Sun 10.30am - 80 people - 16 years and over must have evidence of a double vaccination certificate upon entry

These numbers will increase on November 24th, at this date the above Masses will be for those 12+ who have been double vaccinated.

From Nov 5th, the Parishes of the Ballarat Region are offering six extra Masses for parishioners with no vaccination status required - Thirty people will be able to attend and it will be a requirement to book in with the respective parish.
