flights from Australia, another saunter across Spain is going exceptionally well. Places like Madrid, Segovia and Leon have their attractions but its out in isolated rural areas where the various Camino paths come into their own. While there's a tidal wave of pilgrims currently surging along the traditional Camino Frances, my 320 Camino de Madrid from Madrid to Sahagun and 280km Camino Invierno from Ponferrada to Santiago de Compostela are quite different. Most nights I've been by myself in pilgrim accommodation equivalent to a small hotel and on two nights have shared this with one other pilgrim who amazingly hails from Castlemaine. Earlier this week there was heavy rain and flash flooding across Spain and the umbrella I brought with me to shield me from the Sun came in handy for a different purpose! Thankfully I was in a mountainous region and didn't need my snorkel. I hesitated accepted my "Carta Peregrina" certificate for completing the Madrid Camino as I don't like carrying extra weight then decided one extra piece of A4 paper shouldn't be too much of a burden. Now closing in on my tomb of the apostle Santiago (St James) destination and by this time next week I'll hopefully be in Jerusalem for my Mark's Gospel course. Adios! Fr John
