BALLARAT CLERGY SUPPORT FUND ANNUAL APPEAL:

"Caring for those who've cared for us." Seventeen retired priests are currently supported by this Fund that provides accommodation and care for the retired clergy of our diocese. Some live privately, some in units in Ballarat and elsewhere, others live in supported accommodation. A special collection will be taken up after Communion at all Masses this weekend.

SR MARGARET MARY CASSIDY CSB: Sr Margaret Mary, who served in our community for ten years (1973-820) died last Saturday, August 5, 2023.

Margaret Mary, who came originally from Cobram, arrived here at the start of 1973. So she taught during the final year of St Joseph's College, and became one of the pioneers of the world's first venture into Ecumenical Schooling, at what began as The Christian Community College and is now known as Highview College. She was much-loved by pupils and staff alike. As well, she began to lead our parish choir. Maryborough had a good tradition of church music, going back over a hundred years. But, along with Ray Severino, our organist, Margaret Mary built on that.

Later on Margaret Mary served a term as Provincial Superior of the Brigidine Sisters in Australia.

For a time she had to take leave of absence from the Brigidines, spending only a day a month with a Brigidine community, so that she could look after her brother, a retired lawyer in Cobram, who was suffering from dementia and becoming very difficult to manage. She cared for him faithfully until his death.

Recently, she developed dementia herself, but she was able to remain living with the Brigidines in Malvern until the last couple of months, when she had to be placed in a nursing home.

May God reward richly this very faithful servant of God and God's people.
