Focus on the Scriptures

st Sunday is often called the birthday of the Church. For the ancient , Pentecost (meaning 'fiftieth') was a harvest festival celebrated 50 days a beginning of the harvest. When the Jerusalem Temple was built, this festival was transformed into a pilgrimage feast to celebrate the at that God had made with Israel on Mt Sinai. Several decades after the F Jesus, the early Christians reflected on their origins and chose this feast the birth of God's new covenant with God's people.

eaching at the heart of the new covenant, we turn to the gospel read-John. The risen Christ appears to the disciples who are huddled behind doors. He offers the simple greeting: "Peace be with you," the greeting r each other at every Eucharistic celebration. He sends them on a of peace in continuity with his own God-inspired mission. He breathes on e gift of the Holy Spirit and tells them that God will forgive those whom give, and will "retain" or "seize hold of" the transgressions of those whose ansgressions they "retain".

the enduring conflict in our world derives from the inability of ordinary and of leaders to know how to deal with transgression. The Holy Spirit is ue source of our power to forgive, of our capacity to deal with the pers of violence, and of the strength we need to refrain from vengeance. He desire for vengeance often inhibits healing in those who have sufplence or abuse, and even in those who endeavour to support them, so
