We abandoned the little ones: Pope Francis

Pope Francis has acknowledged the Church "did not act in a timely matter" to protect children from sexually abusive priests over a period of decades, saying in a letter to Catholics that the Church "abandoned" minors. Source: *NCR Online*.


"With shame and repentance, we acknowledge as an ecclesial community that we were not where we should have been ... realising the magnitude and the gravity of the damage done to so many lives," the Pontiff said in the letter, released yesterday in response to the Pennsylvania grand jury report.

"We showed no care for the little ones; we abandoned them," the Pope said.

In the three-page letter, addressed to the "People of God," Francis also says the Church has "delayed" in implementing measures to protect children and to hold those who have abused them to account.

Although Francis did not outline specific steps for the Church to adopt, he said "no effort must be spared" to protect children and called on Catholics globally to consider taking up the spiritual practices of prayer and fasting to foster solidarity with those who were harmed.
