During the confidential small group conversations, synod delegates are now expected to consider the following questions:

- 1. How can we walk together toward a shared awareness of the meaning and content of mission?
- 2. What should be done so a synodal church is also an "all ministerial" missionary church?

Bishop Shane Mackinlay of Bendigo, a synod delegate, has been appointed by Pope Francis to the committee which will draft the final synthesis document for the Synod on Synodality, has expressed his approval for women's ordination to the diaconate in an interview with Vatican journalists.
