St Francis Xavier Chapel

St Peter's Parish, Daylesford received a grant from the Victorian Government, Living Heritage Grants Program, to restore and conserve the structure and amenity of the Chapel. The visitors will be introduced to the 153 year old history of the Chapel and receive an outline of the planned conservation.

ST FRANCIS XAVIER CHAPEL & EGANSTOWN CEMETERY In August 2017, St Peter's Parish, Daylesford, the controller of the Chapel and Cemetery, was successful in an application for a Grant under the Living Heritage Grants Program. We have received our initial funding and the works have progressed under the guidance of Ms Mandy Jean, Architect / Heritage Consultant and we have now lodged documentation for the relevant permits.

Conservation works will commence in May 2018 and we propose to have an open day on Saturday, 26 May 2018 when we will invite our community, the descendants of families interred in the cemetery and the public at large. We will engage with the Hepburn Shire Council, the Daylesford & District Historical Societv and local organisations.

A sausage sizzle will be provided on the open day.
