COVID UPDATE

In regional Victoria, we are currently under Stage 3 restrictions.

The regulations require that "religious ceremonies and private worship" be "broadcast only". This means that our churches are closed to the general public. For information about Masses online, please go to the diocesan website at www.ballarat.catholic.org.au

In regional Victoria, there are exceptions for weddings and funerals, though with limited numbers. For weddings, there may only be 5 people (the couple, two witnesses and the celebrant). For funerals, there may be up to 10 people, plus those conducting the funeral.
