Focus on the Scripture

Both the first reading and the psalm response celebrate the marvels of creation and the marvellous creator who brought them into being. Proverbs states that God created all of these things through Wisdom. While later theology will identify Wisdom with both the Word of God, the second person of the Trinity, and the Holy Spirit, the third person, the reading itself does not suggest this.

Paul credits God with our justification through faith. Justification or salvation is accomplished by God through our Lord Jesus Christ. The love of God is poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit. Paul does not clearly state that the love of God that we receive through the Holy Spirit sanctifies us, but one could certainly understand it in this way. John's theology resembles very closely that of Paul. In it, Jesus reveals the intimate connection between himself and the Father as well as himself and the Spirit. The Spirit continues the mission of Jesus, neither adding anything to his teaching nor omitting anything from it.

While this is a feast that glorifies the central mystery of our faith, a mystery that is based on the way the three divine persons relate to each other, the readinas all address ways that God relates to us. If we concentrate, as the texts for today suggest that we do, on all of the ways that our Triune God has blessed us, we may be more inclined to cry out with the psalmist: 'O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!'

Holy Communion to the Homebound. Option II & III

Current practice. For many years our Special Ministers have been taking Holy Communion from Mass of a Sunday to the homes of those parishioners prevented from attending Mass through illness, age or similar circumstances. This will still continue.

If a parishioner is no longer able to drive themselves to Mass we will arrange to have capable parishioners on hand at the church to assist if a parishioner chooses to come by taxi. We can help in and out of taxi, and wait with them until taxi arrives after Mass.

An added option: If there is someone who would like to receive Communion at home, we would invite a parishioner who lives near or who is nominated by them to take communion to them from whichever Mass they attend. Some practice and prayer resource will be given. This is building up "neighbourhood church".

If you are aware of any parishioner who has been a regular but is unable to attend Mass now and might like to receive Holy Communion at home could you either let us know or ask them and if OK, pass their name and address and your name and phone number to the parish office.

We will also include a prayer at the end of Mass for the sending out of Special Ministers to the sick.
