Kathleen's Corner

Farmers protest against coal seam gas in CBD fracking rally. The Age September 20, 2015

Hundreds of Victorian farmers and their metropolitan supporters rallied against the coal seam gas industry on the steps of parliament on Sunday. The protesters vowed to stop unconventional gas drilling, or fracking, from gaining a foothold across the state. "If [Victorians] want to eat clean, healthy food and drink clean water, we have got to stop the industry," he said. At the beginning of this year, the Victorian government extended its moratorium on coal seam gas exploration and fracking pending a Parliamentary inquiry. The inquiry, tasked with examining the science and impact of the coal seam gas industry's methods, is due to hand down its final report at the end of the year.

For Those Who've Come Across the Seas: Justice for Refugees and Asylum Seekers

The Australian Catholic Bishops' Social Justice Statement for 2015 challenges Australians to think again about our national response to asylum seekers, especially those who come to Australia by sea. It invites us to recognise the desperation that has driven these people to seek refuge far from their homes. The title, taken from the words of our National Anthem, is intended to remind all Australians of how this nation has aspired to be a place of welcome and inclusion.

The Bishops address the divisive national debate over asylum seekers, especially those who arrive by boat. They confront Australia's current deterrence-based response and remind us of the needs of the nearly 60 million people who are displaced around the world. The Statement takes its inspiration from the actions and words of Pope Francis on his 2013 visit to the Italian island of Lampedusa, where he met the survivors of a refugee tragedy and mourned for those who had died. It begins and ends with the Pope's own words and is strongly based on the Scriptures and Catholic teaching.

The Bishops' document traces the experiences of asylum seekers from their flight from persecution and danger, through their perilous journeys, to their experience in Australia of indefinite detention, deprivation and insecurity. It asks why both sides of Australian politics have felt the need to introduce such cruel and self-defeating policies as offshore processing and indefinite detention.

This Social Justice Sunday we are invited to reflect on the call of Jesus to welcome those in most need and to give comfort to those who come to us in flight from fear and suffering.
