<u>within us:</u> It is the abiding presence of God within us that enables us to face the future with undying hope and true Christian courage. However, it is necessary for us to spend a little time each day in personal prayer talking to God and listening to Him. We must deepen our relationship with Jesus, learn to get in touch with him, and sincerely love him. The Holy Spirit teaches us through the Scriptures and preaching during the Holy Mass.
