<u>Note from Bishop Paul on progress about pastoral care</u> <u>arrangements for the Parish of Gordon</u>

"As you may recall, Sue Daly and Vin Dillon met with parishioners in March. They then prepared a report, which I was able to discuss with them before leaving for Rome for the Ad Limina visit. My plan was to provide parishioners with a letter summarising the next steps after returning from Rome. In fact, I had drafted a letter on July 22. Then, on July 23, there was the announcement that Fr Shane Mackinlay had been appointed Bishop of Sandhurst. My draft letter presumed that there would be a Visiting Priest for Gordon. While Fr Shane will be able to continue this service until early October, he will then move to Bendigo, and will no longer be Parish Priest of Bungaree nor Visiting Priest for Gordon. While this has delayed the announcement of proposals for Gordon, I would like to assure you that I will be doing all I can in the coming weeks to provide for Gordon as well as for Bungaree for when Fr Shane concludes his time with us. God bless you all."
