<u>Ballarat Clergy Support Fund</u> Collection for Sick and Retired Priests

The Ballarat Clergy Support Fund provides for retired priests who have spent a lifetime selflessly caring for others, and who deserve a happy and peaceful retirement. The Fund is currently supporting and caring for eighteen retired priests. Over the next few years a number of priests currently in parish ministry will be moving into retirement, and will also need to be supported by the fund.

This collection has raised nearly 1.7 million dollars since it began in 1991, including nearly \$54,000 last year. Along with the priests' own contribution of approximately \$38,000 per year, this annual collection has allowed the Fund to continue to support our sick and retired clergy. Special envelopes are available for this collection. A credit card facility is available, and contributions over \$2 are tax-deductible.

Child Protection Sunday

The accounts of child sexual abuse have continued to affect our entire community and diminish the trust some have placed in our Church. That trust has been further eroded when the institution has failed to respond appropriately to the victim's needs. At the same time, the Catholic Church is in a unique position to offer much experience and insight in creating stronger communities that are safer for children. One such example can be seen in Pope Francis' apostolic exhortation Amoris Laetitia, where he encourages families and communities to become stronger, more capable and more resilient, through love strengthened by generosity, commitment, fidelity and patience. Stronger families and communities can then help to keep children safe. As the Royal Commission begins to finalise hearings and close registration for private sessions, Child Protection Sunday invites us to reflect on the steps we have taken to make children safer in our communities: at home, in our churches, schools and Catholic agencies.

A Prayer for Stronger Communities and Safer Children Gracious God, you said 'let the children come to me.'

The hurt felt by those wounded by abuse weighs heavily upon us.

Lord, as your Church we stand in need of your healing and help. We ask you to strengthen and guide all in our Catholic communities.

Grant us wisdom in our time to make decisions that protect children and the vulnerable.

May our families and communities be strengthened through love, generosity, commitment and patience, so that they are safer for children.

Let your grace and love fall gently upon children, giving them the inner strength, peace and resilience they need for their life's journey.

May our Catholic communities be resolute in building a community where our children flourish and are safe.

We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
