Thank you to the parishioners who were able to attend the Parish Assembly to be informed of the current state of our vibrant and active parish. Reports were presented, received and discussed with an opportunity for those present to express their ideas/thoughts/challenges in an open forum. Discussion took place around the discernment process for our lay-led community and the appointment of a new coordinator in 2016. Names will need to be submitted prior to Christmas.
